- 3.3.1 Does your university as a body have current collaborations with local, national or global health institutions to improve health & wellbeing outcomes? Yes. For medical care of students at the university we have a medical room, equipped in accordance with the requirements of sanitary norms.

Types of services provided there:

- provision of first aid to students;
- referral to medical center for medical care
- organization of preventive medical examinations of students;
- control over the students registered for dispensary services;
- carrying out anti-epidemic measures when infectious diseases are detected;
- dynamic observation of persons in contact with those who have had infectious diseases;
- promotion of healthy lifestyles, sanitary and hygienic education
- sanitary and educational work;
- drawing up an inoculation plan for newly admitted students according to Form 063 (vaccination card);

3.3.6 - Does your university as a body have a "smoke-free" policy?
