Newsletter:

It is our young scientists who make a huge contribution to the success of the University. Their arrival in the field of science is the result of the fact that conditions of interest are being created by the state and the measures taken. Funding for the science sector from the budget has increased almost 2 times over the past two years. The term of grant funding for research projects has been extended to 5 years. If earlier the competition for grants was held once every 3-5 years, now it is held annually. Reporting has decreased, bureaucratic barriers have been removed.

Private grants are provided for young scientists. Scholarships for undergraduates and doctoral students have increased significantly. Special prizes were awarded to young researchers. On behalf of the head of state, Kazakhstani scientists were given the opportunity to undergo internships in the world's leading scientific centers. Thus, all conditions are created for the implementation of scientific ideas and potential of young scientists.
